Support

Birmingham College promotes learner independence and respects learner voice. All students on full-time courses have an Individual Learning Plan (ILP), keep a Learner Journal to develop self-reflection and are entitled to a weekly individual tutorial. The procedures we have in place for English language diagnostic assessment on your arrival enable us to identify your current level, Learning Style and establish your aims and objectives. We also conduct regular progress checks and self-assessment questionnaires to ensure you stay focused and to support progress throughout the programme. In order to monitor quality and learner satisfaction there is a first-week feedback form, a midcourse survey and an end of course survey. All students will be allocated their own course representatives and will be given the opportunity to attend monthly focus group meetings with a member of senior management for regular feedback and to raise any issues of concern.

General English Language Programme

This programme covers the skill areas of speaking, listening, reading and writing as well as systematically building grammar skills and knowledge, plus paying attention to pronunciation. The topic and the students are the focus of the week's work, not just one textbook, and there is a progress check every Friday. Students who are planning to stay for a short time can focus on their personal interests by following their Individual Learning Plan.

'General English' does not mean students do not have a specific reason for improving their English language skills. The teaching team will always try to focus on your interests and advise you how to continue developing. The course includes an element of Learner Independence training.


For those who want extra out of their stay, you can combine the General English Language with IELTS. This will provide candidates with the chance to develop some Academic English skills and become familiar with the skills and strategies required for the IELTS examination, which is evidence of and a requirement for English language level for UK University admissions.

Students often work with a partner or in small groups in class, but are also expected to complete homework tasks and work individually on areas of interest outside class.

On completion of your studies you will receive a Birmingham College Certificate in *General English Language Studies / General English Language Studies with IELTS*, indicating length of stay, an estimated level of English plus an individual progress report based on class performance, progress tests and tutorial records.

IELTS Programme

In IELTS there is no 'pass' or 'fail'. Students can work towards their own individual targets and everyone is welcome to participate in and benefit from the IELTS workshops. We expect students who are preparing for IELTS to be highly motivated and do a lot of independent work outside class.



This programme is designed for students who have a specific interest in improving their IELTS bands by developing examination skills and strategies while at the same time expanding their vocabulary and increasing their accuracy in grammar structures. The programme includes IELTS-specific skills classes, plus a few sessions working with General English students in order to help develop communication skills. This programme will also develop your Academic English skills which will help with higher education studies as well as IELTS.

On completion of your studies you will receive a Birmingham College *Certificate in IELTS Preparation Studies, Intensive IELTS and Academic Study Skills,* indicating length of stay, an estimated level of English plus an individual progress report based on class performance, progress tests and tutorial records.

IELTS Preparation & One-to-one Classes (local students)

In order to support local students who intend to take IELTS at local test centres, we allow candidates to attend workshops/ drop in sessions for IELTS preparation, plus we offer one-to-one classes. Students may take as few or as many classes as they need.

To attend workshops/ class drop in session the cost is £25 per session. For one-to-one IELTS classes it is £40 per hour. If you would like to attend these classes or the one-to-one lesson please contact **does@bcol.co.uk** to book your places. You will not be permitted to attend the classes or one-to-on sessions without booking in advance.

Course Requirements

There are no requirements. However please note we are not able to take absolute beginners on any of the programmes. Contact the college for more information if you are unsure of your level). All courses have a minimum duration of two weeks to make sure students have sufficient time to develop and use their skills (except Option 5)

Class siz

At Birmingham College we have a maximum class size of 18.

Social Life in Birmingham
